



We provide training free of charge to those who work directly or are responsible for activities with children, young people or vulnerable adults in our churches from the Union of Welsh Independents, Baptist Union of Wales and Presbyterian Church of Wales.

Our training is based on the policies and practice as found in the Safeguarding Vulnerable Groups [handbook](#). Training aims to help workers and volunteers to be familiar with current guidelines and know what to do if they have safeguarding concerns or are concerned about an individual or situation. Safeguarding training is essential for all those who work or volunteer with children, youth or vulnerable adults and is necessary to meet the requirements the Charities Commission and most insurance policies.

We currently offer the following safeguarding training:



**LEVEL 1 SESSIONS** are suitable for volunteers.  
(2 hours)



**LEVEL 2 SESSIONS** are mandatory for accredited ministers, leaders and staff.  
(6 hours)



**LOCAL CHURCH SAFEGUARDING COORDINATOR SESSIONS**  
(2.5 hours)



**DBS VERIFIERS SESSIONS** : how to check a DBS application and do an I.D. check.  
(45min – 1 hour)

**SAFEGUARDING TRAINING FOR TRUSTEES** We do not offer specific training for charity trustees although the content in the above sessions will be relevant to them. The Panel Safeguarding officer recommends the following safeguarding training for charity trustees.
